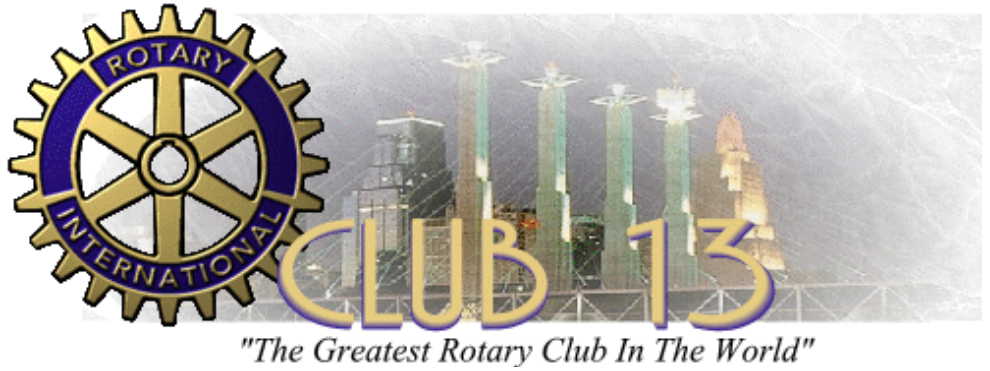

### Thomas M. Hoenig

President, Federal Reserve Bank of Kansas City



As president and CEO of the Federal Reserve Bank of Kansas City, Thomas M. Hoenig is also a member of the Federal Reserve System's Open Market Committee, the key body with authority over monetary policy.

After receiving his doctorate in economics from Iowa State University, Hoenig joined the bank in 1973 as an economist. He was named president in October 1991, assuming responsibility for Federal Reserve activities in the seven-state Tenth District - an area that includes Colorado, Kansas, Nebraska, Oklahoma, Wyoming, the northern half of New Mexico and the western third of Missouri.

Hoenig's civic activities include serving as chair for Benedictine College in Atchison, KS, and on the board of trustees of the Ewing Marion Kauffman Foundation. He also serves on the boards of Midwest Research Institute and Union Station.

**Steve Burger's** glimpse into the heart and character of former Chief Justice Warren Burger was a fantastic lead in to the 4<sup>th</sup> of July holiday. **Steve** recalled two characteristics of his "Uncle Judge," common sense and a belief in the Bible, that set the pattern for Justice Berger's life.

A justice with a conservative's view of our constitution, Justice Burger said his mother, using her common sense, could handle 60% of the cases that came before the Supreme Court. He wanted his legacy to be a justice system that worked even for "the least of these my brethren".

**Steve** provided an interesting peek into post-WW2 U.S. politics by revealing the character of his uncle and many of his contemporaries. As a leader of Minnesota Republicans, Warren Burger had a pivotal role in the presidential nomination of Dwight Eisenhower. Long

-time political opponent, Hubert Humphrey respected Burger's character and championed his nomination to the Supreme Court through the Senate. The admiration was mutual as Justice Berger referred to Senator Humphrey as the most compassionate man in Washington, "truly a man without guile."

Taking the helm, new President **Sally Bibb** called us to order and lead us in the Pledge of Allegiance. **Ted Dalberg** and **Carl Bolte** helped us honor Rotarians with July birthdays and conducted us through "My Country 'Tis of Thee." **Dennis Chapman** gave the invocation and **Bill Early** welcomed our guests and one visiting Rotarian.

## Give Me Five Program



Every Rotarian can participate in our "Give Me Five Program."

Any member who brings in one, two or up to five new members can receive a dues credit based on the type of member, e.g., Actives (83.50); Under 35 and Not-for-Profits (71.75) and Past Service (32.). This amount will be credited to your account like the previous plan over a two-year period. This program places a value on the type of membership but is limited to your first five members in a calendar year.

Tyrotarians can earn 10 points on the tyro orientation project list by serving as a primary sponsor for a new member.
