Last Thursday **Patrick O'Malley** ticked off a list of O'Malley brothers and sisters faster than I could count, or at least faster than I could write 'em down. He ended the list introducing his youngest brother, Terence O'Malley, who fascinated the room telling the Nelly Don story. In doing that he shared clips of his film that documents the life of Nell Donnelly, the Kansas City businesswoman who changed the way American women dressed as she built the Nelly Don Garment Co. That company employed more than a thousand Kansas Citians in the 1930s and sold "upward of 75 million" dresses.

O'Malley packed his presentation with intriguing KC history as Nell's story intertwined with attorney, Mayor and later Senator James A. Reed, political boss Tom Pendergast and mobster John Lazia.

Donnelly built the world's largest dress factory 3500 East 17th that later

was known as the Sears Cleveland Avenue store and is now a US Postal Service sorting facility. Although she became wealthy, Nell's greatest satisfaction came from "improved, more cheerful lives for millions of women," according to O'Malley.

This first meeting in July was the start of a new season as President **Rick Halterman** called us to order for his first Thursday meeting presiding at Club 13's podium. Our favorite tenor, **Bob Lager**, and "piano man" **Carl Bolte** led us through musical birthday greetings for July Rotarians and *My Country 'Tis of Thee*. Observing July Fourth, **Marcia Bolton** shared quotes of Thomas Jefferson for our invocation. **Cynthia Dillard-Parres** introduced our guests and visiting Rotarians. Prez **Rick** led us in the Pledge of Allegiance and asked us to remember **Dick Berkley**, **Don Smith**, **Frank Toplikar** and **Cynthia Weber**, all of whom are dealing with health issues.
